

BMCA Special Meeting

Date/Time: Wednesday, September 16, 2015 7 p.m.

Attendance: 19 members, 28 total

Minutes: *(Note: not necessarily in chronological order as presented during the meeting)*

1. Sandra Spear reported on the progress of the newly incorporated Reeves Farm Conservation Society, Inc. She then answered questions from the audience.
2. On the motion of Josh Handler, the voting members adopted the following resolution 15-0-4: **“The group supports the general direction of the Reeves Farm Conservation Society and looks forward to future reports on its progress at future meetings.”**
3. The meeting discussed the Wilson Blvd restriping and specifically the request from the Bluemont Civic Association that our CA sign on to their letter requesting that the western terminus of the restriping be moved west from Four Mile Run to the top of the hill on Wilson west of Dominion Hills Recreation Association. On the motion of Marie Powell, the voting members adopted the following resolution 13-0-4: **“The BMCA declines to sign the letter written by Bluemont Civic Association, objects to alterations to the striping until the study results are reported, but supports studying means of improving safety at the intersection of N. Manchester St. and Wilson Blvd.”**
4. The meeting discussed requesting storm water capture at 4th Street and N. Manchester as an additional Neighborhood Conservation Project.
5. The meeting adjourned.
